## Calling Singers for Thursday

Region 13 is now accepting SINGING VOLUNTEERS to participate in our technical rehearsal and sound/lighting check for the upcoming Region 13 Chorus Competition in Spokane WA. This is an exciting, educational opportunity open to ALL members (competing and non-competing) who are attending the Regional Convention in May 2024.

The technical rehearsal and sound/lighting check will take place on Thursday, May 16, 2024 at 4:00 PM. Singers will need to arrive at the Spokane Convention Center Ballroom at 3:45 PM, ready to get on the risers to perform for the Judging Panel so they can set the sound and lighting levels. We will use the regional song *How We Sang Today*. Learning tracks and music are available on the <u>regional website</u>. You will need to sign in to access these.

#### **Event Tickets**

Single event tickets for either the quartet or the chorus contest will be available on the day of the event at the TicketsWest booths in the breezeway across from the FICA entrance. The ticket booths open two hours before each contest starts. \$35/general admission; \$25/seniors, 65+, and military with ID; free: youth 12 and under.

All Events Tickets (AETs) are available for purchase at the registration desk in the lobby of the Spokane Convention Center. AETs are required for entry to all events during Convention week.

This venue allows only clear "stadium bags" or the small clutch purses that are now common practice at most sport and event venues.

## **Thursday Night Kick-off**

Choruses: be prepared with something fun, like banners, flags, a cheer, etc. for the Chorus Roll Call.

### Contest "Purses" and Backstage Bags

**PURSES**: The "purse" for the traffic pattern should be a CLEAR, stadium type. You can also use the 1-gallon Ziplock bags we have used in the past. More information here.

**BACKSTAGE BAGS:** for carrying clear purses and zip-lock bags from one side of the stage to the other. **Each chorus is limited to a maximum of 6 large bags.** These bags may be reusable or not and should be no larger than 19 x 17 x 7 (similar to the large bags sold at Home Goods, TJ Max, Ross, etc.). Each chorus is responsible for providing its own backstage bags. Please remember that all purses for the entire chorus must fit inside these large backstage bags.

#### Schedules

The Thursday Night Kick Off schedule is posted on the Convention Website. The tentative convention schedule and traffic patterns are also posted there. The final

schedule and traffic pattern will be posted on the convention website as it gets closer to contest, and published in the convention program as well.

#### **Contest Venue Entry**

Single Event ticket holders, AET holders in the audience that are not competing that day, competitors not entering from the stage directly to their seats, or competitors who leave and return after performing must adhere to the clear bags only policy as well as the container policies. Metal water bottles are not allowed. Additionally, concessions are all cashless, so be sure to bring your debit or credit card.
