We will celebrate the Novice Director, Novice Quartet, and Most Improved Quartet, as well as announce the winners of the 2023 Tag Writing Contest. There is no charge to attend the Show of Champions; however, donation buckets will be at entrance doors. All donations received help with regional costs.

#### **Afterglow**

#### Webcast

YES! Region 13 will be webcasting our quartet and chorus contests once again for the 2023 contest. The cost is \$25 and will be broadcast live and then archived for one week following the contest. Tell your family and friends! Register NOW at Region13webcast.com.

#### **Event Tickets**

Single event tickets for either the quartet or the chorus contest will be available on the day of the event through TicketsWest in the breezeway to the FICA. \$35 for general admission; \$25 for seniors 65+ and military with ID; free for youth 12 and under. Friends and family are encouraged to arrive early enough to go through venue security. This venue allows only clear "stadium bags" or small clutch purses, a now common practice at most sport and event venues. More venue information here.

All Events Ticket (AET) are available for purchase at the registration desk in the DoubleTree lobby. Cash or check only. AETs are required for entry to all events

during Convention week, including the Thursday night Kickoff and Saturday night Show of Champions.

#### **Contest Venue**

The First Interstate Center for the Arts (also known as the FICA, PAC, INB and Opera House!) allows only bottled-water type containers into the venue. You may bring in an empty water bottle through security and refill it after entering the venue, or purchase water from the concessions and refill as often as you wish. NO metal, glass or hard plastic bottles of any kind.

Concessions are all cashless, so be sure to bring your debit or credit card.
