The team approved the October meeting minutes and summary.

Details of the January RMT retreat in Spokane were discussed.

Sally informed the team that we have not received any applications for the RMT Membership or Team Coordinator positions. RMT are encouraged to reach out to members to help fill these important positions.

Sharon received team updates on RMT visits with Chorus leaders.

Patty reported that she is still seeking individuals to fill the Director Certification Program Coordinator and Director Mentoring Program Coordinator positions. She has communicated with Director's about holiday performances and heard how joyous it is to sing in-person again.

Cherie is preparing for the next quarter's Marketing Leadership Forum. There will be a focus on using YouTube as part of a marketing program.

Shelly will be reviewing November 2022 SET plans with the committee members. Discussion was held regarding transitioning the Leadership Development Task Force to a Regional Committee reporting to the RMT Team Coordinator. A Visual Communications class is being planned for Regional Convention.

Jan Matthews was officially welcomed as the Financial Coordinator and approvals were received to update our accounts with US Bank. Jan is going to apply for the Alaska Air EasyBiz program to streamline airline reservations for the region. The 2022 Regional calendar year budget will be finalized at the January RMT Retreat.

Jody presented an update on the 2022 Regional Convention. A member of the convention team is attending the Men's Midwinter Festival to observe the process for COVID protocols and will present information to the RMT. She asked that members watch for Convention eBlasts. Sandy asked members to watch their junk/spam folders in case the eBlasts are
