

Sessions will be devoted to arranging the Project Song in your choice of groups: Beginning / Less Experienced Arrangers with Janice Wheeler, or More Experienced Arrangers with Mike Menefee, or Advanced Arrangers with Chuck Roegiers. Results from all three groups will be shared on Friday.

Other scheduled activities and classes include Mike and Chuck teaming up to present **Arranging for Different Ensembles**, a Friday morning **Tin Pan Alley session** where the Grand Prize Winners of the 2019-2020 and 2020-2021 Tag Writing Contests will present their winning tags, and, **private arrangement review sessions** available on a first-come, first-served basis for those who have personal arranging work they would like to discuss with faculty members.
