She has been a fantastic member of the RMT and will become a valuable resource to the person who transitions into this position. To select this person, members of the region will vote for their preferred applicant, and the individual receiving the greatest number of votes will become the new Membership Coordinator.

Team Coordinator: The Team Coordinator position is exactly that: this person provides overall support for the functions of the team as a whole. She organizes RMT meetings and also oversees the nominations process and standing rules review. To select this person, current RMT members will review and discuss all applications and determine the Team Coordinator by consensus.

It is with regret that I am announcing Cascade Harmony Chorus has dissolved. Most of you may already know this, but I wanted to acknowledge this long-standing chorus, which will be missed. Happily, many of their members are still "ringing those barbershop chords" with other Region 13 choruses.

Cascade Harmony's former longtime member, LaVeda Redfield, who is now deceased, was an arranger of barbershop music. Throughout the years, royalties from her arrangements went into an account from which

Cascade Harmony donated \$1904.97 to Region 13 for educational purposes. The RMT has set this money aside to use for future arranger education, of which I am sure LaVeda would approve. Thanks to Cascade Harmony Chorus for this generous gift and for their longtime service to our Region 13! Below is a quote from LaVeda's son, Duane Galen Redfield:

"LaVeda Redfield was an official arranger, got involved with copyright permissions, etc. and had a very modest trickle of royalties that she wanted to see used in something educational like teaching choruses how to put on shows, or sending someone else to arranger's school. Mom was kind of a miniature legend in her day.'

Along with this donation, Cascade Harmony sends much love and harmony to Region 13!

Many of you have been concerned about having your chorus standing rules reviewed and approved. Well, worry no more! Our Regional By-Laws Specialist, **Judy Beckman**, is ready to receive and review your documents.

Here is the process:

- Judy will review chorus standing rules to ensure they comply with the requirements set forth by Sweet Adelines International (see <u>Guide for Regional Standing Rules</u> on the SAI site).
- 2. Once a chorus' standing rules are determined to be compliant and complete, Judy will send a copy to SAI for their review and approval.
- 3. After receiving SAI approval, Judy will notify the Region 13 Management Team, who will formally approve them and make them official.

Standing rules are to be reviewed every three years, and Judy is creating a database to track this process for all our choruses. Please email your chorus standing rules to Judy at heyjude4@live.com.
