While most of us are familiar with Microsoft Office products, many others only have limited exposure to the collaborative power of Google Workspace (formerly Google Suite).

- 1. Learn how to *create* a new Google doc

ASCAP music license...do we need one?



The American Society of Composers, Authors, and Publishers (ASCAP) licenses the public performances of its members' musical works. A public performance is one that occurs in a public gathering place other than a small circle of family or social acquaintances. A public performance can also be one transmitted to the public via radio, TV broadcasts, and the internet. Performing at rest homes or caroling is considered a benevolent performance and does not need an ASCAP form.

With many of our choruses performing during the holidays, it is important to ensure an ASCAP form is submitted. Provide her with your full name, email address, and chorus membership (or CAL).

If you are one of our wonderful **Membership Leaders**, please take a moment to <u>log in to</u> <u>the Members Only website</u>, choose **Members** from the side menu, click in the **Filters** box, select your chorus from the list in the **Role** field, and review your list of members that appears. If there are members missing or members listed who are no longer with your chorus, please let Mindy know so she can remove them from our databases.
