Providing members with opportunities to grow

The North by Northwest Region 13 Education Team is committed to providing our Region 13 membership with opportunities to connect and learn. We meet regularly to identify what we consider gaps--or opportunities!--in our education program. You will see several new opportunities over the next year that will become a permanent part of our program.

Here are a few examples:

- Level Up Program: Learning targeted at choruses scoring at C / C+ level who are ready to move to the next level. This is similar to the PEP program and involves both musical and administrative training. This program will be piloted with a few choruses over the next year.
- Section Leader Training: Learning directed at current and future musical leaders. The first workshop in this program will be August 20-21. <u>More information here!</u>
- Leadership Development Training: Learning directed at chorus administrative leaders. The next workshop in this program will be September 25.
- **Technology for Chorus Leaders:** This future program is being developed and will provide training opportunities in different tools that can help leaders organize and communicate.
- Visual Communication Training: This future program is being developed and will provide training opportunities for visual, performance, and creative leaders.

The team has also been looking at ways to bring our educational offerings to the next level, offering opportunities for more advanced learners or those who wish to push their skills to the next level.

We recently held a Thought Leader Forum with a small group of individuals to brainstorm ideas on how we can fill this learning opportunity. This provided us with a bucketful of ideas we will be able to integrate into our educational offerings for anyone who is looking to take a deeper dive into certain topics. We will be incorporating designators on classes, starting with SET, to help attendees better select the class that fills their bucket.

In addition to these new programs, we continue to have ongoing educational offerings, such as the <u>Arrangers Workshop</u> at HCNW, <u>SET</u> (November 11-14 with Dale Syverson), PEP visits, quartet education, YWIH, director education, and so much more.
