What about the 3-year competition requirement? Will video submissions count?

At the March 2020 International Board of Directors (IBOD) Meeting, the decision was made to institute a presidential waiver for the 3-year competition requirement for a chorus to re-charter. Under this waiver, a chorus would have to compete in-person during either 2022 regionals or 2023 regionals, which would restart their 3-year competition requirement.

Because of COVID-19, a further presidential waiver has been granted that allows any chorus participating in the 2022 regionals, in either a live contest setting or by video, in any division, will have fulfilled their competition requirement and would not have to compete at a live contest again until 2025. Any chorus that does not participate in 2022 regionals will need to compete at a live contest in 2023.
