Our Youth Outreach Program

NxNW Region 13 is committed to promoting barbershop singing to youth who reside within the boundaries of our wonderful region. Region 13 has restructured and rebranded our current offerings to help clarify what is available by both Sweet Adelines International (SAI) and Region 13.

While SAI's programs encompass Young Women In Harmony (YWIH) and Young Singers Fund, Region 13 programs will now be referred to as NxNW Youth Education Outreach. This will help differentiate between the two programs and provide more inclusive language to our regional programs.

Sweet Adelines International Youth Programs

Young Women in Harmony (YWIH)

- Young Women in Harmony is an educational program designed to provide opportunities for students to explore the world of barbershop.
- It provides complimentary resources (music, guidebooks, etc) to schools and Sweet Adeline choruses to incorporate barbershop into curriculum and/or to hold barbershop festivals.
- It produces the Rising Star Contest and Young Women in Harmony (YWIH) Video Chorus Contest.

Young Singers Fund

• The Young Singers Fund is a charitable-giving program that is currently part of the *Life on a High Note* campaign. This fund was formerly part of the Young Singers Foundation.

• The Young Singers Fund also supports YWIH events such as the Rising Star Contest and their Video Chorus Contest.

North by Northwest Region 13 Youth Education Outreach Program

The Region 13 Youth Education Outreach Program is separate from the SAI Youth Programs, although our aim is similar.

NxNW Youth Education Outreach

- The NxNW Youth Education Outreach program provides appointed specialists, who are knowledgeable about promoting and engaging youth in barbershop singing, to be part of the education team.
- These Youth Education Outreach Specialists are available to provide support to choruses or educators within the boundaries of Region 13 who wish to hold barbershop events for young singers under the age of 25.
- The Youth Education Outreach Specialists serve as liaisons for Region 13 and for SAI's YWIH program. They are also knowledgeable about youth barbershop programs that are available through other barbershop organizations.

NxNW Youth Education Stipend

- Region 13 provides annual funding to support youth barbershop activities within the boundaries of Region 13. An amount of \$250 is available for each of Region 13's six zones to support youth barbershop activities or events.
- The applicant can be a Region 13 chorus member, educator, festival organizer, scouting leader, or other organizer of youth barbershop activities that meets the criteria.
- Membership in Sweet Adelines is not a requirement to receive this stipend. The intent of the award is to encourage Region 13 choruses and educators to hold events and programs promoting barbershop to youth under 25 years of age.

Our next installment of NxNW Presents is *PVIs under Glass*, where we will conduct a series of workshops with smaller audiences, based on voice parts. These sessions will be held over Zoom and run periodically through the end of April. In addition to vocal tips, some of our amazing regional faculty will provide brief Personal Vocal Instructions (PVIs) right on Zoom. Workshops are limited to approximately 25 attendees, including 3 people who will receive a PVI while others observe (you can always learn something from observing!). Volunteers will be selected on a first-come, first-served basis, so register early to secure your spot.
