

## New DCP modules coming soon!



Region 13 candidates for the Director Certification Program (DCP) should be aware that SAI has nearly completed revisions of some its modules. New modules will be available for purchase later this spring. In the meantime, we will not be offering any testing on the affected modules, as the previous testing material will be outdated. SAI hopes to have the new modules out in May.

The modules affected are Module 3: Organizational Knowledge, and Module 7: Vocal Production. SAI is also revising Module 11, which deals with performance, though there is no testing material on this subject at this time.

The next opportunity for testing in person will be at Region 13's Summer Enrichment Training (SET), which will be held this August. However, SAI did make on-line testing available during the COVID protocols, and DCP candidates interested in doing on-line testing should contact me at <a href="heyjude4@live.com">heyjude4@live.com</a> or 541-645-0172.
