
YOUNG WOMEN IN HARMONY

- Designed to provide opportunities for students to explore the world of barbershop
- Provides complimentary resources to schools and Sweet Adeline choruses to incorporate barbershop into curriculum and/or hold festivals.
- Produces the Rising Star Contest and YWIH
 Video chorus contest

YOUNG SINGERS FUND

- One of four funds that are currently part of the Life on a High Note giving program
- Formally known as Young Singers Foundation
- Donations to the Youngs Singers Fund support youth outreach such as funding for festivals, camps, and educational programs for youth under 25..
- The fund also supports YWIH events such as Rising Star and the video contest.

N x NW YOUTH EDUCATION OUTREACH

- Youth Specialists* are appointed as part of the Region 13 Education Team
- The specialists provide support to choruses or educators within the boundaries of Region 13 that wish to hold barbershop event for young singers under the age of 25
- The Youth Specialists serve as a liaison for Region 13 with SAI's YWIH program

N x NW YOUTH EDUCATION STIPEND

- This program would be administered by the Scholarship Chair* who serves as part of the Finance Team.
- Annual funding to support youth barbershop activities within the boundaries of Region 13
- \$250 budgeted to support each of Region 13 's six zones for a total of \$1500.
- The applicant can be a Region 13 chorus, educator, festival organizer, scouting leader or other organizer of YWIH activity that meets the criteria. Membership in Sweet Adelines is not a requirement to receive this award.
