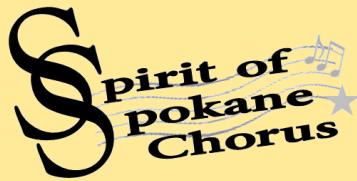

SPIRIT OF SPOKANE CONTEST MAKEUP
MAKEUP APPLICATION



- * Nails may be painted clear/neutral only. No white tips please.
- * Apply your own moisturizer one hour before applying makeup.

1. Cover your entire face, neck, and chest with Fawn Foundation. Blend and smooth out as you move towards hairline and down the neck and chest. Use sponge to apply. Then set with Translucent Powder using brush. Do not put makeup on lips.
2. Apply White Pearl Sheen Shadow to upper part of eyelid just under the eyebrow using sponge tipped applicator.
3. Apply Black Plum Shadow to crease of eyelid blending toward lash line. Use shadow brush.
4. Apply Espresso Eye Pencil to lower lash line and eye brows.
5. Apply your own Black Mascara to lashes.
6. Apply Black false eyelashes.
7. Line lips with Red Diva lip liner. Make sure to apply out to corners of lips.
8. Apply Ruby Red Lipstick. Make sure to apply out to corners of lips.
9. Apply Flame Red Rouge to apples of your cheeks blending toward temples with blush brush.

MAKEUP

- Fawn foundation (Ben Nye)
- White Pearl Sheen eye shadow
- Black Plum eye shadow
- Espresso Eye pencil
- Black Mascara
- Black false eyelashes
- Red Diva lip liner (Rimmel 024)
- Ruby Red lipstick (Ben Nye)
- Flame Red rouge (Ben Nye)

COSTUME

- Red Shiny tunic,
Black velvet pants
- Body shaper undergarment
- Jet Black L'eggs brand hose
- Black stage shoes
- Rhinestone & Red Earrings
- Full stage make-up (*above*)
- Hairstyle to accentuate your face and show your eyes
- No other jewelry, except wedding ring

Hello Sun! Relax! Have Fun!

- You may wear comfy shoes on the way to the stage provided they will fit in the Ziploc bag "purse" you're given.
- Pack nutritious snacks & beverages to have in your room.
- Drink plenty of water, early and often!
- Tabletop mirrors are helpful in your room.
- Visit your makeup checker early please, for your sake and hers.
- Have extra safety pins, maybe a small sewing kit. Remember to pack your AET.
- Bring your own washcloth for removing the bulk of stage make-up.
- Plan ahead how you will style your hair. The audience wants to see your EYES!
- Clear nail polish, no white tips
